

NURS 406: Leadership & Management in Nursing

Application of the nursing metaparadigm to synthesize nursing knowledge of health issues across a multi-cultural lifespan population. Basic epidemiology principles, concepts and procedures will be discussed in the relationship to population-based healthcare. Health prevention (primary, secondary, and tertiary) and health promotion principles will be emphasized. This course has didactic and clinical components. The clinical course will involve community and simulation experiences in varied settings. 3 credit hours.
